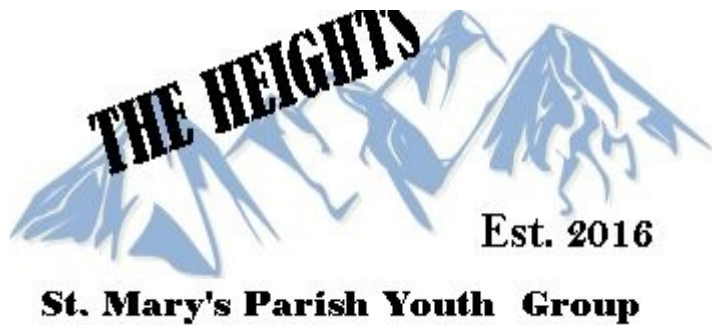

## "SCRIP Cards and Certificates are available after Mass in the Gathering Space" What DOES that mean???

### What it is:

When you purchase SCRIP, you are purchasing gift certificates or prepaid gift cards that are used just like cash. You can use SCRIP to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing, fuel, dining out, and other essentials. With every purchase, you earn rebates for your family's Light of Christ tuition account or towards tuition assistance for a family in need.

### How it works:

Local and national restaurants and retailers sell their gift cards and certificates to St. Mary's Grade School at a discount ranging from 2%-20%. The school resells the gift cards at their face value so a small margin of profit is made from every card sold. 80% of the profits earned from the cards that are purchased go directly towards a family's tuition account or tuition assistance. The remaining 20% of the profit goes to the school to cover costs associated with maintaining the SCRIP program.

### Ways to buy:

If you would like to designate rebates earned to a personal tuition account, the tuition account of another family, or to the general tuition assistance account, school families **and parish members** may complete a St. Mary's SCRIP Rebate Program Agreement. SCRIP cards are available for purchase in the St. Mary's Grade School office or after each of the weekend Masses. Online orders that are placed by 6:00pm Sunday evenings will be available the following Thursday for payment and pick-up.
